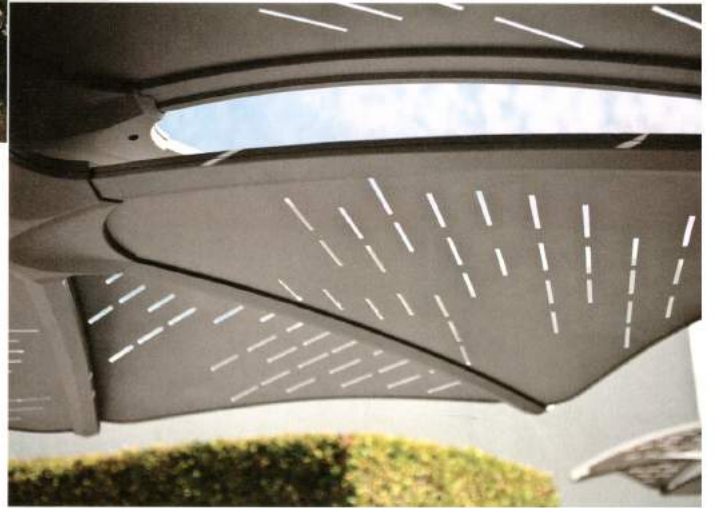




• **SOLERIS SUNSHADE**
