1. The clear Tulip Hanging Light from Cox London is an elegant studio-blown glass shade that is often used in a set of three above a kitchen island, or to light hallways in your home. Various sizes, shapes and colors are available. coxlondon.com

2. The Sofia dining side chair (20 %" w. x 21 %" d. x 37 %" h.) from Engle & Deutch, available through **Raoul Textiles**, is noted for its turned walnut legs and stylized ladder

back. The medium brown hue is complemented with a seat of Indonesian rush. raoultextiles.com

- 3. Maison & Co. has recently added to its inventory this French 19th-century caststone garden basket (17  $^{3}4''$  h. x 15  $^{3}4''$  diam.). The sculpted assortment features fruits and flowers, and takes on a rich patina. *maisonandco.com*
- 4. Although it's called the Bread Basket, this sturdy woven container (18" w. x 22" l. x 36" h.) at **The Iron Gate** is as much a decorative item at home as it is a practical and lovely one for storing anything from throw blankets and magazines to children's toys. theirongateonline.net
- 5. Minimal in form, this mid-century metal tripod floor lamp (73 1/4" h. x 26" w.), available at **Maison**, was made in France, circa 1960. Elegant in a room, it stands tall and provides abundant light, as well as a sculptural presence. *maisonshoppe.com*
- **6.** Mississippi-based artist Lee Malouf has created a new and striking work entitled *Inhale*, which is available exclusively through **Tara Shaw**. The artwork (30" h. x 22" w.) reveals an alluring series of black brushstrokes, at once abstract yet accessible. *tarashaw.com*
- 7. When lit, the Governor Scroll from Bevolo Gas & Electric Lights illuminates outdoor areas at your home in new and bright ways. Its scroll bracket adds a decorative look to the fixture, which is available in natural gas, propane, or electric modes. bevolo.com

8. Marcello Fantoni's wall sculpture (18 3/4" h. x 21 1/2" w.) is signed and dated, 1974, by the late Italian artist (1915–2011). The incised glazed ceramic plaque, available at Antonio's Bella Casa, is an  $ideal\ example\ of\ the\ artist's$ oeuvre, many pieces of which are in notable museum collections.

9. A perfect element by the pool or on your terrace, the Mirasol umbrella from Santa Barbara Designs is both practical and decorative. The Cadet Grey features a Marquis-style valence with black edge binding. A flame-style finial finishes off the look. santabarbaradesigns.com

10. The Jake Stripe in Black Tie (available in 14 colorways) from Perennials is made of 100% solutiondyed acrylic, making the bold graphic pattern fade-, mildew-, and mold-resistant. perennialsfabrics.com

11. Useful to an artist or simply as a novel decorative item at home, this antique oak artist's easel (69" h. x 25 ½" w. x 21 ½" d.) is available from Robin Rains Interior Design + Antiques. The H-frame item features an adjustable crank and casters. robinrains.com

**12.** The Chareau Robe Chair from **Munder** Skiles assumes a relaxed, natural profile when set in your yard or on your terrace. Its woven fabric, sinuous lines, and graceful back panel replicate the effects of a luxurious robe. munder-skiles.com

has long been known for recreating elegant designs inspired by the decorative arts of 17thcentury France. This covered tureen (17" diam. x 15" h.) certainly references those historical precedents while also feeling modern. dennisandleen.com
